

**The Norfolk County Council
(Attleborough, Various Roads)
(20 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the “Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (20 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 11th day of September 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Church Street, Exchange Street, Queens Road, Queens Square) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 is hereby revoked on the commencement of this Order.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
