

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (WICKLEWOOD)**

**(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1997**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. This Order comes into operation on the 27th day of June 1997, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Wicklewood) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1997.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

**SCHEDULE**

**In the Parish of Wicklwood**

C166 Hackford Road	-	from a point 75 metres east of its junction with the U78209 High Street westwards and northwards to a point 370 metres north of its junction with the U78066 Milestone Lane.
U78209 High Street	-	from its junction with the C166 Hackford Road northwards to a point 65 metres north of its junction with the U78172.
U78064 Low Street	-	from its junction with the U78209 High Street eastwards for 600 metres.
U78965 Church Lane	-	from its junction with the C166 Hackford Road northeastwards to its junction with the U78209 High Street.
U78066 Milestone Lane	-	from its junction with the C166 Hackford Road southwards for 315 metres.
U78172	-	for its entire length.
U71026 Hillside Crescent	-	for its entire length.
U78068 The Green	-	from its junction with the C166 Hackford Road for a distance of 25 metres.
