The Norfolk County Council (Bawburgh, Colney and Little Melton, Various Roads) (40 mph and 50 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Bawburgh, Colney and Little Melton, Various Roads) (40 mph and 50 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 4th day of December 2025.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. The Norfolk County Council (Bawburgh, Colney and Little Melton, Various Roads) (40 M.P.H. and 50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2019 is hereby revoked.
- 6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

40 mph Speed Limit

B1108 Watton Road	From a point 300 metres east of its junction with the U78470 Old Watton Road (eastern leg of junction) westwards to a point 80 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the C772 Green Lane
C170 Stocks Hill	From a point 490 metres south of its junction with the southern junction of the U78131 Church Street southeastwards to its junction with the B1108 Watton Road

Schedule 2

In the Parishes of Bawburgh and Little Melton

50 mph Speed Limit

B1108 Watton Road	From a point 80 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the C772 Green Lane westwards for a distance of 1600 metres
C772 Green Lane	From a point 300 metres north-west of its junction with the C169 School Lane northwards to its junction with the B1108 Watton Road
