

**The Norfolk County Council
(Bawdeswell, Various Roads)
(30 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Bawdeswell, Various Roads) (30 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 17th day of December 2025.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Norfolk County Council (Bawdeswell) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2007 is hereby revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.


Schedule

In the Parish of Bawdeswell

30 mph Speed Limit

U35284 Dereham Road	-	From its junction with the U35147 Paradise Lane south-westwards to its southern most end
U31021 Foxley Road	-	From a point 195 metres northwest of the centrepoint of its junction with the U35284 Dereham Road northwards to its junction with the A1067 Fakenham Road
U35147 Paradise Lane	-	From its junction with the U35223 Paradise Road south-eastwards and south-westwards to its junction with the U35284 Dereham Road
U31021 The Street	-	From its junction with the B1145 Norwich Road/Reephams Road south-westwards for a distance of 23 metres
