

**The Norfolk County Council
(Bracon Ash, Chapman Way and Potash Lane) (Hethel)
(30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84, 122A and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Bracon Ash, Chapman Way and Potash Lane) (Hethel) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 19th day of September 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

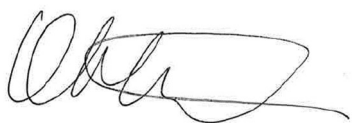
Schedule

In the Parish of Bracon Ash

30 mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
Chapman Way (New Link Road)	From a point 19 metres north of its junction with the C186 Wymondham Road for 394 metres northwards to its junction with C825 Potash Lane
Chapman Way (Access to Hethel Engineering Centre spur)	From its junction with Chapman Way eastwards for a distance of 52 metres
C825 / U78010 Potash Lane	From its junction with Chapman Way northwards for a distance of 1054 metres
