

The Norfolk County Council
(Bressingham and Fersfield and Roydon, Various Roads)
(40 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Bressingham and Fersfield and Roydon, Various Roads) (40 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 18th day of May 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Schedule 2 of The Norfolk County Council (Bressingham and Roydon) (30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 1996; Schedule 2 of The Norfolk County Council (Roydon) (30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Parishes of Bressingham and Roydon

40 mph Speed Limit

U76009 Fersfield Road	-	From a point 167 metres northwest of the centreline of its junction with the U76014 School Road westwards for a distance of 390 metres.
A1066 High Road	-	From a point 20 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U76231 Tottington Lane south-eastwards to a point 70 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the U70023 Denmark Lane
