

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(BRESSINGHAM, SCHOOL ROAD)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2005

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4), and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the U76014 School Road from its junction with the U76009 High Road to its junction with the A1066 High Road, at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Bressingham and Roydon) (30 m.p.h., 40 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1996" - insofar as that order refers to its entry for the U76014.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 16th day of December 2005 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Bressingham, School Road) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2005.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
