THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ROYDON, HALL LANE) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the U76073 Hall Lane, in the parish of Roydon, from its junction with the A1066 High Road to its junction with the U76010 Baynards Lane, at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. The following Orders will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Roydon)(30 m.p.h., 40 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 2003" – insofar as that Order refers to its entry for the U76073 Hall Road in Schedule 3 of that Order;

"The Norfolk County Council (Bressingham and Roydon)(30 m.p.h., 40 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1996" — insofar as that Order refers to its entry for the U76073 Hall Road in Schedule 1 of that Order.

- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 4. This Order comes into operation on the 9th day of November 2012 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Roydon, Hall Lane)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2012.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
