

**The Norfolk County Council
(Roydon, Various Roads)
(50 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation Order 2026**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Roydon, Various Roads) (50 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 18th day of May 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Schedule 3 of The Norfolk County Council (Roydon) (30mph, 40mph and 50mph mph Speed Limits) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Parish of Roydon

50 mph Speed Limit

A1066 High Road	-	From a point 392 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the U76014 School Road, Bressingham, south-eastwards to a point 55 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the U76074 Bellrope Lane.
C338 Doit Lane	-	From its junction with the A1066 High Road south-wards for a distance of 25 metres.
