

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (CRINGLEFORD, VARIOUS ROADS)
(20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2016**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), having given public notice in accordance with sub-section (2) of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of June 2016 and may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Cringleford, Various Roads) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2016.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, the provision of this Order shall prevail.

20 m.p.h. Speed Limit

7P255/10 Dragonfly Lane North East	-	From a point 20 metres South of its centre line of the southernmost junction with U7P122/10 Jasmine Walk. Northeast to a point 11 metres East of centre line with junction northernmost junction with U7P122/40 Jasmine Walk. East of centre line with junction Lobelia Lane
7P166/12 Brambling Lane North West	-	From its junction with Dragonfly Lane Westwards and Northwards for a distance of 158 metres
