

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (CROMER, HALL ROAD)

(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the U14290 Hall Road, in the town of Cromer, from its junction with the A148 Holt Road southwards for a distance of 206 metres, at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The County Council of Norfolk (Built-Up Areas) Order 1936" – insofar as that Order refers to its entry for Hall Road in the town of Cromer.
- 3. This Order comes into operation on the 1st day of April 2011 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Cromer, Hall Road)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2011.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
