The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

The Norfolk County Council (Stratton Strawless) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1997 in its entirety.

3. This Order comes into operation on the 29th day of April 2005, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Stratton Strawless and Felthorpe, Shorthorn Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2005.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
