

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (FELTHORPE)(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1997

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads) (No. 5) Order 1967 is hereby revoked and the County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads) (No.1) Order 1976 is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 20th day of June 1997 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Felthorpe) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1997.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULEIn the Parish of Felthorpe

Felthorpe Road/The Street (C245)	-	from a point 217 metres south-west of the centreline of Mill Lane (U57150) north-eastwards to a point 28 metres north-east of the centreline of Bilney Lane (U57169).
Mill Lane (U57150)	-	from Felthorpe Road/The Street (C245) north-westwards for a distance of 514 metres.
Taverham Road (C262)	-	from Felthorpe Road/The Street (C245) south-westwards, westwards and southwards for a distance of 542 metres.
Church Lane (U57211)	-	from Taverham Road (262) south-eastwards for a distance of 207 metres.
Hall Lane (U57212)	-	from The Street (C245) north-westwards for a distance of 735 metres.
Bilney Lane (U57169)	-	from The Street (C245) south-westwards for a distance of 394 metres.
Nash Road/School Field (U57506)	-	for the entire lengths
