

**The Norfolk County Council  
(Gorleston-on-Sea, Various Roads)  
(On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026**

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council, (Great Yarmouth (Gorleston, Various Roads) (On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 2026.

2. In this Order –

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

"Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by this Order

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the General Directions

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

"Class of Vehicle" means the class or type of Vehicle permitted in a particular Parking Place as specified in column 3 of the Schedule and 'Classes of Vehicle' shall be construed accordingly;

"Disabled Parking Place" means a Parking Place identified by surface markings and/or signage for the parking of Disabled Persons Vehicles and being those Parking Places which specify Disabled Persons Vehicles in column 3 of the Schedule as the permitted Vehicle which may use the Parking Place

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 and a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, if

- (a) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle: or
- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle

“Driver” means the person responsible for the control of the Vehicle and in relation to a Vehicle waiting in a Parking Place means the person driving the Vehicle immediately prior to parking it in the Parking Place;

“Excursion or tour” has the same meaning as in section 137(1) of the Transport Act 1985

“General Directions” means The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016

“Heavy Commercial Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act

"Invalid Carriage" has the same meaning as in section 136(5) of the Act;

"Motor Car", "Motor Cycle" and "Motor Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act;

“Taxi” and “Taxi Rank” have the same meaning as in the General Directions

“Trailer” means an unpowered Vehicle with wheels that can be towed by a powered Vehicle;

Vehicle means any vehicle whether motorised or otherwise and includes but is not limited to any Motor Vehicle, Motor Car, Motor Cycle, Invalid Carriage or anything attached to, forming part or being carried on the vehicles and shall also mean any Trailer whether attached to another vehicle or not;

Any reference to “parking” means leaving a stationary Vehicle in a Parking Place for any period of time whether the Vehicle remains occupied or not, whether engine is disengaged or not and “park” and “parked” shall be interpreted accordingly. For the avoidance of doubt “wait”, “waiting”, “stand”, “standing”, “leaving”, “leave” and “left” shall also be interpreted as parking in accordance with this definition.

### Parking Place provisions

3. The section of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as Parking Places for such Classes of Vehicles, in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that section of road in the said Schedule.
4. Nothing in this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close any Parking Place by order for a temporary period under sections 14 or 16A of the 1984 Act or under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.
5. Where in the Schedule to this Order a Parking Place is described as available for Vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to wait in that Parking Place -
  - (a) unless it is of the specified Class of Vehicle in column 3 of the Schedule;
  - or

- (b) in a position other than specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- 6. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to wait in a Parking Place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the Schedule to this Order in relation to that Parking Place.
- 7. Where in the Schedule or within this Order, a Parking Place is described as having a period within which a Vehicle may not return, no person shall permit a Vehicle to wait in that Parking Place on any day, during such hours within which the Vehicle is excluded from waiting in the Parking Place.
- 8. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in a Disabled Parking Place unless the Vehicle lawfully displays a Disabled Persons' Badge in the relevant position.

#### Use of Parking Place

- 9. A Driver of a Vehicle shall not use a Parking Place -
  - (a) so as to prevent or obstruct access to any premises adjoining the sections of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule; or
  - (b) so as to prevent or obstruct the use of the road outside of the marked Parking Places by other persons; or
  - (c) so as to prevent or obstruct the driving away of any Vehicle already standing in the Parking Place or other Vehicles generally
  - (d) when the Council has closed the Parking Place has been closed by order for a temporary period under sections 14 or 16A of the 1984 Act or under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.
- 10. The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the Vehicle is in the Parking Bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- 11. No person shall use a Vehicle while it is in a Parking Place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services provided that Taxi's may collect and drop off pre-arranged passengers in the course of their business but are not permitted to use the Parking Place as a Taxi Rank.
- 12. Except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council no person shall distribute, affix or cause to be affixed any advertising material to any Vehicle left in a Parking Place.
- 13. The Driver of a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument expect when about to change the position of the Vehicle or to depart from a Parking Place
- 14. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council drive any Vehicle into a Parking Place other than for the purpose of

leaving that Vehicle in that Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from that Parking Place

15. No person shall, while a Vehicle is in a Parking Place, permit the carrying out of any work of maintenance, service or repair thereto except such as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle to be moved from the Parking Place.
16. No person shall except with the authority of the Council use a Parking Place or any Vehicle left in a Parking Place:
  - (a) for sleeping or camping purposes
  - (b) for preparing or cooking food or washing crockery, cutlery, clothing or any other articles or things whatsoever
  - (c) for the purpose of servicing, cleaning or washing any Vehicle or part thereof
  - (d) for the purpose of advertising or promoting any cause, event or other matter whatsoever or for the distribution of leaflets or other material
  - (e) for the erection of any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure
  - (f) for skateboarding, roller skating or wheeled activity which may be hazardous to other traffic or pedestrians
  - (g) for the instruction of pupils whilst undertaking driving lessons
  - (h) to play or take part in any game
17. In a Parking Place no person shall:
  - (a) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire
  - (b) soil, obstruct, misuse defile, remove, displace or damage any wall or fence in or enclosing the Parking Place or any building, barrier, bollard, post, notice, sign (including markings such as Parking Bay markings), railing, or any other erection, furniture or amenity therein;
  - (c) damage or destroy or cause to be damaged or destroyed any part of the fabric or structure of the Parking Place; or
  - (d) throw down, drop or otherwise deposit in any Parking Place any item or article of rubbish or waste material so as to contribute to or tend to lead to the defilement of that Parking Place by litter.

#### Removal of Vehicles

18. Subject to the provisions hereto, when a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any provisions of this Order, or is left in such a manner so as to cause danger or an obstruction or it is necessary to meet the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised on behalf of the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform may remove the Vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the Parking Place or may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle in order that its position shall comply with the provisions of this Order or meet the requirements of the emergency.
19. Any person removing or altering the position of a Vehicle in accordance with Article 19 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the Vehicle or in such other manner as that person may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the Vehicle as that person may think necessary to enable that person to remove or alter its position

20. When a person authorised by the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a Vehicle from a Parking Place, by virtue of Articles 20 and 21 that person shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the Vehicle.
21. The Council shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to the Vehicle or to anything contained therein or attached thereto arising from or in consequence of the exercise of its powers in Article 20 to 22.

#### Exemptions

22. Nothing in this Order shall prohibit the waiting of a Vehicle in a Parking Place beyond the maximum period of waiting in column 6 of the Schedule or returning within the time period set out therein where that Vehicle lawfully displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge.
23. Nothing in this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any Vehicle to wait in a Parking Place in contravention of the conditions and use provisions set by this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
  - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of roads; or
  - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning in, or near , the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Digital Economy Act 2017 lawfully kept in any position;
  - (v) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
  - (vi) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes
  - (vii) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (viii) to wait when the person in control of the Vehicle is required to stop by law, or is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstance outside their control
  - (ix) as part of a funeral cortege where the Vehicle is owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral Vehicles
24. The following orders are revoked on the date of commencement of this Order:


