

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(GREAT YARMOUTH, GORLESTON, RIVERSIDE ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2019**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Gorleston, Riverside Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 2019 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 21st day of March 2019.
2. The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Gorleston, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the "2015 Order") is amended by the addition of the lengths of Riverside Road as set out in the Schedule of this Order.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Town of Gorleston

Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

U61545 Riverside Road Westside	-	From a point of 100 metres north of its junction with the C606 Quay Road/Pier Walk northwards for a distance of 20 metres.
U61545 Riverside Road Westside	-	From a point 24 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U61204 Baker Street northwards for a distance of 15 metres.
U61545 Riverside Road Eastside	-	From a point 24 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U61204 Baker Street northwards for a distance of 40 metres.
U61545 Riverside Road Eastside	-	From a point 17 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U61212 Dock Tavern Lane northwards for a distance of 36 metres.
