THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HEMPTON AND DUNTON)

(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the A1065 Raynham Road/Gravel Pit Hill/Swaffham Road from a point 133 metres north of its junction with the U14007 Shereford Road southwards to a point 66 metres south of the centreline of its southernmost junction with the C333 Hempton Road, at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
- 2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Hempton and Pudding Norton)(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2006" – insofar as that Order refers to its entry for the A1065 Raynham Road.

- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 4. This Order comes into operation on the 2nd day of September 2011, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Hempton and Dunton) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2011.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
