

The Norfolk County Council
(Honingham, C174 Taverham Road)
(30 mph Speed Limit) Amendment Order 2026

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Weston Longville, C175 Taverham Road) (30 mph Speed Limit) Amendment Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 3rd day of August 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Norfolk County Council (Morton on the Hill, Weston Longville and Honingham, Various Roads) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2025 is amended insofar as specified in the Schedules of this Order.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule 1

In the Parish of Weston Longville

Remove the following entry:

Road	Description
C174/10 Taverham Road	from a point 38 metres north of its junction with the existing A47 for 395 metres northwards

Schedule 2

In the Parish of Weston Longville

Insert the following entry:

30 mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
C174/10 Taverham Road	from a point 243 metres north of its junction at the Norwich Road Junction North Roundabout for 359 metres northwards
