THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HUNSTANTON, CROMER ROAD/OLD HUNSTANTON ROAD) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the A149 Cromer 1. Road/Old Hunstanton Road, in the Parish of Hunstanton, from a point 40 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the U20015 Clarence Road northwards to a point 220 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the B1161 Lighthouse Lane, at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
- The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this 2. Order as follows:-

"The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 4) Order 1980" - in its entirety.

- This Order comes into operation on the 23rd day of February 2007, and may be 3. cited as The Norfolk County Council (Hunstanton, Cromer Road/Old Hunstanton Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2007.
- Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous 4. Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
