

**The Norfolk County Council
(Drayton, Kybird Close, Sidney Bunn Way)
(20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Consolidation Order 2025**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Drayton, Kybird Close, Sidney Bunn Way) (20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Consolidation Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 8th day of December 2025.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule in this Order shall cease to be restricted roads.
5. The Norfolk County Council (Drayton, Kybird Close, Sidney Bunn Way) (20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2025 is hereby revoked.
6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

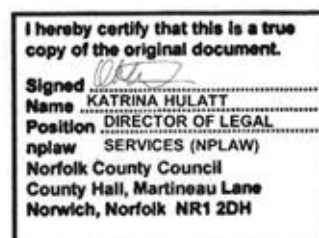
Schedule

In the Parish of Drayton

20 mph Speed Limit Zone

Road	Description
5P318 Kybird Close	From its junction with the 5P317 Sidney Bunn Way north westwards and northwards for its entire length including the turning heads, a total distance of 84 metres.
5P317 Sidney Bunn Way	From its junction with the A1067 Drayton High Road south westwards and westwards for its entire length, a total distance of 278 metres.
