The Norfolk County Council (Keswick and Intwood, A140 Ipswich Road and U71576 Ipswich Road Service Road) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2025

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Keswick and Intwood, A140 Ipswich Road and U71576 Ipswich Road Service Road) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 21st day of November 2025.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

In the Parish of Keswick and Intwood and in the City of Norwich

40 mph Speed Limit

A140 Ipswich Road	from the northern arm at the Harford/Southern Bypass Roundabout, at its junction with the A47 northwards to a point 105 metres north of its junction with the C802/2 Hall Road, a distance of 1400 metres.
U71576 Ipswich Road Service Road	from its junction with the A140 Ipswich Road for 40 metres south-eastwards.
