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THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (CRINGLEFORD AND KESWICK, LOW ROAD)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2009

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the C184 Low Road, from a point 87 metres south-east of the centreline of its junction with the U78471 Mark Lemon Close, in the Parish of Cringleford, south-eastwards to a point 39 metres south-east of the centreline from its junction with the western arm of the U78028 Keswick Hall Road, in the Parish of Keswick.
2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Keswick) (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 1998" – in its entirety.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 27th day of March 2009 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Cringleford and Keswick, Low Road)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2009.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
