## The Norfolk County Council (Kings Lynn, Gayton Road) Toucan Crossing Notice 2025

As required under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Part 3, Sections 23 and 25, notice is hereby given that the Norfolk County Council propose to install a Toucan pedestrian crossing and associated Toucan controlled area on the A1076 Gayton Road at a point 40 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the 20779 Winston Churchill Drive. Distances measured are to the centreline of the pedestrian crossing.

The reason for the proposal is to provide a safer environment for pedestrians within an urbanised area and to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
