

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (LODDON AND CHEDGRAVE VARIOUS ROADS)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below, at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
2. The following Orders will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

“The Norfolk County Council (Loddon)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1996” – in its entirety;

“The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 3) Order 1971” – in its entirety;

“The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 1) Order 1966” – in its entirety;

“The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 1) Order 1967” – in its entirety;

“The County Council of Norfolk (Built-up Areas) Order 1936” – insofar as it refers to its entries for the Parish of Chedgrave;

“The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 2) Order 1975” – insofar as it refers to its entry for the Parish of Chedgrave;

“The Norfolk County Council (Chedgrave and Loddon)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1988” – in its entirety;
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This Order comes into operation on the 9th day of August 2013 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Loddon and Chedgrave, Various Roads)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2013.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
