

**The Norfolk County Council
(Narborough, Denny's Walk)
(20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Consolidation Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Narborough, U33312 Denny's Walk) (20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Consolidation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 2nd day of February 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Norfolk County Council (Narborough, Denny's Walk) (20 M.P.H. Speed Limit Zone) Amendment Order 2018 is hereby revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Parish of Narborough

20 mph Speed Limit Zone

Road	Description
U33312 Denny's Walk	From its junction with the C45 Marham Road westwards to its junction with the U31077 Old Vicarage Park
U33318 Denny's Walk	From its junction with the U33312 Denny's Walk southwards for 57 metres including turning heads.
