The Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Carrow Road/King Street) (Right Turn Restriction) Order 2025

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Carrow Road/King Street) (Right Turn Restriction) Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 11th day of October 2025.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer (within the meaning of section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004) in uniform cause any vehicle proceeding along the length of the A147 Carrow Road to make a right turn into the C861 King Street between the hours of 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:00, Monday to Friday (inclusive).
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to make the prohibited right turn where that vehicle is used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes whilst on emergency business.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
