

**The Norfolk County Council  
(Rackheath, Harmer Drive and Stanway Road)  
(20 mph Speed Limit) Zone Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Rackheath, Harmer Drive and Stanway Road) (20 mph Speed Limit) Zone Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

**Schedule**

In the Parish of Rackheath

20 mph Speed Limit Zone

<b>Road</b>	<b>Description</b>
5P514 Harmer Drive	From its north junction with the 5P513 Stanway Road to its south junction with the 5P513 Stanway Road, a distance of 72 metres
5P513 Stanway Road	From its junction with the C258 Green Lane West eastwards for its entire loop including turning head, a distance of 400 metres
