

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (SIDE ROADS, ROLLESBY)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1992

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. This Order comes into operation on the 10th day of August 1992, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Side Roads, Rollesby) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1992.

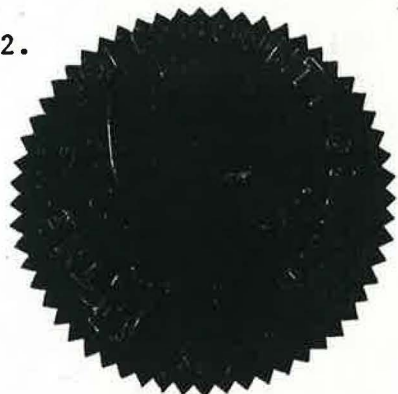
SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Rollesby

- Martham Road - from its junction A149 Main Road northeast to a point 165 metres northwest of the centre line of Back Lane.
- Back Lane (West) - from its junction with Martham Road eastwards to a point 220 metres east of the centreline of Park View Avenue.
- Back Lane (East) - from its junction with A149 Main Road northeast and northwest for a distance of 355 metres.
- Court Road - from its junction with A149 Main Road to its junction with Low Road.
- Low Road - from junction Court Road westwards for a distance of 330 metres.
- Bittern Road)
- Park View Avenue)
- Coronation Avenue)
- King George Avenue)
- King George Close) entire length
- Meadow Way)
- Meadow Lane)
- School Close)
- Grebe Close)
