THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ROUGHTON)

(30 AND 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1995

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 4th day of August 1995, and may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Various Roads, Roughton) (30 and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1994.
4. Insofar as any provision of This Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Roughton

- Brownsfield Close - entire length.
- Old Turnpike Road - entire length.

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parish of Roughton

- A140 Norwich Road - from the northern side of the junction with Back Lane northwards to a point 270 metres north of the centre line of Heath Lane.
- B1436 Thorpe Road - from the junction with A140 eastwards for 511 metres.
- B1436 Chapel Road and Felbrigg Road - from the junction with A140 north-westwards to a point 203 metres north of the centre line of Metton Road.
