The Norfolk County Council (Swaffham, A1065 London Street/ Brandon Road) (20mph Speed Limit) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2024

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84, 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Swaffham, A1065 London Street/ Brandon Road) (20mph Speed Limit) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2024 and shall come into effect on the 12th day of April 2024 for an experimental period of 18 months.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
- 3. Pursuant to and in accordance with Section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, the Norfolk County Council's Executive Director Community and Environmental Services, or a person authorised by him, is hereby empowered to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision contained in it if it appears to him essential:-
 - (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
 - (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities; or
 - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
- 4. Whilst the provisions of this Order are in place the provisions of the following Orders will be suspended in so far as they relate to the length of road described in the Schedule to this Order:-
 - (a) The County Council of Norfolk (Built Up Areas) No. 2 Order, 1939; and
 - (b) The Norfolk County Council (Swaffham, Brandon Road) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2013.
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
