

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (TRIMINGHAM, GIMINGHAM AND
MUNDESLEY, CHURCH STREET/CROMER ROAD)**

(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2006

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the C634 Church Street/Cromer Road from a point 19 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the C294 Middle Street, in the Parishes of Gimingham and Trimingham, south-eastwards to a point 579 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U11360 Fraser Crescent, in the Parish of Mundesley, at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. The following Orders will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 2) Order 1978" – insofar as it refers to its entries listed in the Parish of Trimingham;

"The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 8) Order 1967" – in its entirety.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 16th day of June 2006, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Trimingham, Gimingham and Mundesley, Church Street/Cromer Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2006.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
