

**The Norfolk County Council
(Weston Longville, Various Roads)
(20 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Weston Longville, Various Roads) (20 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 29th day of June 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Norfolk County Council (Weston Longville and Honingham, Various Roads) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2025 (“40mph 2025 Order”) is revoked insofar as specified in the Schedule 2 of this Order.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule 1

In the Parish of Weston Longville

20 mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
U51245 Church Farm Close	- for its entire length
U57040 Church Lane (known locally as Ringland Lane)	- from its junction with C167 Church Street / Marl Hill Road for 145 metres eastwards
U57161 Field Road	- from its junction with C167 Church Street for 70 metres north-westwards
U57317 Link Road	- from its junction with C167 Woodforde Close / Church Street for 70 metres south-eastwards
U57299 Post Office Lane	- for its entire length
C167 Honingham Road / Woodforde Close / Church	- From a point 113 metres south of the C464 Rectory Road to a point 60 metres northeast of its junction

Street / Marl Hill Road / Marl Hill (known locally as Honingham Road / Woodforde Close / Church Street)		with the C172 Ringland Lane and the C172 Morton Lane.
C172 Morton Lane	-	from its junction with the C167 Marl Hill and the C172 Ringland Road for 13 metres north-westwards
C172 Ringland Lane	-	from its junction with C167 Marl Hill and C172 Morton Lane for 17 metres south-eastwards
C464 Rectory Road	-	From its junction with the C167 Honingham Road for 13 metres westwards.

Schedule 2

Remove the following entry from the 40mph 2025 Order:

Road	Description
C464 Rectory Road	From its junction with the C167 Honingham Road for 13 metres westwards.
