

The Norfolk County Council
(Wretton, Various Roads)
(30 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Wretton, Various Roads) (30 mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 6th day of April 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Schedule 1 of The Norfolk County Council (Various Roads, Wretton) (30 & 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1995 is hereby revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Parish of Wretton

30 mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
Church Road / Chequers Lane	From the junction west of Dereham Road northwards for 80 metres to its junction with Wretton Road.
Church Path	For its entire length.
C32 West Dereham / Low Road	From a point 56 metres east of its junction with the U21478 Limehouse Drive to a point 180 metres north-west of its junction with the C51 Church Road.
