THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (WALSOKEN AND WEST WALTON) (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 m.p.h.
- 2. This Order comes into operation on the 20th day of July 2007, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Walsoken and West Walton) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2007.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
