



Decision Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

The period of consultation has ended. This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed 28 days from the date of this notice. This decision notice meets the duty to consult and notify when removing street trees set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

Summary of responses:	There were 13 responses in total. Main feedback consisted of whether replanting could be at a closer location or removal could avoided through any design changes
Decision summary:	The two trees will be felled. The scheme's objective is to improve bus travel, encouraging more people to use this sustainable transport mode whilst minimising tree loss. As advised by NCC Tree Officer, the best location to replant is at St Clements Hill outside house numbers 166a to 172 St Clements Hill, NR3 4DG. 5 heavy standard trees (12-14cm girth) to be replanted by March 2025 as follows including nurturing in early years; Acer campestre 'Elsrijk', Pyrus calleryana 'Chanticleer, Magnolia Kobus, Amelanchier arborea 'Robin Hill' and Ginkgo biloba 'Lakeview'.
