



Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed. From the date of this notice, there is a 28-day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the duty to consult requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021.

- Species:** Sweet Gum (two trees)
- Reason for removal:** As advised by the project's tree specialist, the two Sweet Gum trees' root protection areas are in the location where full-depth construction is required for the new junction layout. The trees would not survive the cutting of their roots to allow construction and so they need to be removed.
- Solutions Considered:** Planting trees within the new scheme footprint was not possible due to lack of space and consideration of access to the local funeral director's site.
- Replacement:** 5 trees to be planted at planted outside house numbers 166a to 172 St Clements Hill, NR3 4DG:
- Acer campestre 'Elsrijk'
 - Pyrus calleryana 'Chanticleer'
 - Magnolia Kobus
 - Amelanchier arborea 'Robin Hill'
 - Ginkgo biloba 'Lakeview'
