

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, WRETTON)

1885

(30 & 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1995

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 (2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 20th day of January 1995, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Various Roads, Wretton) (30 & 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1995.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Wretton

- Church Road/
Chequers Lane - from the junction west of Dereham Road north to a point 80 metres north of the centre line of the junction with Wretton Row.
- Church Path - entire length.

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parish of Wretton

- C32 West Dereham/
Low Road - from a point 390 metres west of the centre line of the junction with School Lane to a point 180 metres north-west of the centre line of the junction with Church Road. A distance of 1100 metres.
