## **PBA044 – Dereham Market Place Gold Standard Bus Stops**

### **Traffic Management Update: Night works**

I am writing to provide an update on the Dereham Market Place bus improvement works, which are currently underway and are expected to be completed by 20 March 2026, subject to weather conditions.

As part of these works, The High Street, between Norwich Street and Market Place, will be closed overnight for five nights from Monday 16 February, between 6:30pm and 6:30am, to allow the installation of a new pedestrian crossing point. These works will take place overnight to minimise disruption during the day and to ensure the safety of the workforce and the public.

Please be assured that we will aim to keep any noisy works from taking place after 11pm, although some work will still be required throughout the night.

During the closure:

- Vehicle access from High Street to Market Place, Church Street, and Quebec Street will not be possible.
- Resident and business access to Church Street and Quebec Street will be maintained via St Withburga Lane, managed by temporary traffic signals, with a signed diversion route in place.
- All other traffic will be required to follow the signed High Street diversion route around the works.

The County Council thanks residents, businesses, and road users for their patience and cooperation while these improvements are carried out.
